

Kaizen Event Facilitator

Course Overview

Participants in this 2-day course gain in-depth knowledge of several types of kaizen. There are many ways to practice kaizen (continuous improvement). The five day "kaizen event" is one of the most common, as well as the typical suggestion system. This course will review the various types of kaizen, how to perform them, and what is required from the organization to make them successful. This class will take the participant through the planning, facilitation and follow up phases of a kaizen event. On completion of this training course you will be able to:

- Identify opportunities for quick improvements and determine if they are 'Quick Wins' or KAIZEN improvements
- Understand the conditions that may lead to a quick improvement
- Explain the KAIZEN methodology for quick improvement
- Explain the difference between a project 'Quick Win' and a KAIZEN Event
- Apply the basic set of tools, forms and procedures to prepare for the delivery of a KAIZEN event
- Create a project schedule for a typical KAIZEN event
- Facilitate a KAIZEN event
