



ISO 14001:2015 Internal Auditor Workshop

Course Outline:

To successfully implement and maintain an Environmental Management System, a company must have an Internal Audit process and use trained auditors to perform the audits. Internal auditors are also a key element in Environmental System improvement. This workshop teaches auditing to the ISO 14001:2015 Standard and places a strong emphasis on promoting employee participation in the improvement process.

- *Identify nonconformity to requirements during an audit.*
- *Report on an audit and follow up on corrective actions taken in response to audit findings.*
- *Describe the actions necessary to maintain a successful and compliant audit program.*

A basic understanding of ISO 14001:2015 and/or your organization's Environmental Management System would be beneficial but not essential to attend this course.
