



# Risk-Based Thinking and Management for QMS based Management Systems *May 19-20, 2026 (8:30am – 12:30pm)*

## Overview:

This comprehensive workshop is designed to provide a clear understanding of the risk management requirements within ISO 9001:2015 and AS9100D. Participants will gain insight into how organizational context influences risk at the enterprise, product, and process levels, and how these factors integrate into an effective management system.

The course also examines practical tools and methodologies to support the implementation of a risk-based approach. Through guided instruction and applied examples, attendees will develop the knowledge and skills necessary to systematically identify, classify, assess, and treat risks, as well as establish a structured action plan to embed risk-based thinking within their organization. This workshop will be presented in two, half day, instructor-led, online training sessions.

- ❖ *Develop a structured approach for implementing and integrating a risk management framework within their organization.*

This course is designed for professionals responsible for planning, developing, implementing, and managing ISO-based management systems. It is particularly beneficial for managers overseeing business and strategic planning, enterprise-level risk management, and those responsible for system, product, project, and operational risk. Participants in these roles will gain practical insights to strengthen risk-based decision-making and enhance overall management system effectiveness.

A basic understanding of one or more ISO-based management systems (e.g., ISO 9001, AS9100, ISO 13485, ISO/TS 16949, ISO 14001, ISO 18001, etc.)
