Overview:

To meet an organization's current needs, without compromising the ability of future generations to meet their needs, organizations must achieve a balance between the environment (sustainable development), society, and the economy. In this ½-day overview training course you will learn how to leverage the principles of the Plan-Do-Check-Act model and risk-based thinking to contribute to your organizations' ability to achieve environmental sustainability through an ISO 14001:2015 Environmental Management System (EMS). You will also review to the changes between ISO 14001:2004 and ISO 14001:2015 to assess how they will affect your organization's EMS.

- *Assess how the ISO 14001:2015 revisions will affect your organization's EMS.*
