



Transitioning to ISO 14001:2015

Overview:

To meet an organization's current needs without compromising the ability of future generations to meet their needs, organizations must achieve a balance between the environment (sustainable development), society, and the economy. Participants in this training course will learn how to leverage the principles of the Plan-Do-Check-Act model and risk-based thinking to contribute to their organizations' ability to achieve environmental sustainability through an ISO 14001:2015 Environmental Management System (EMS). You will use a variety of tools to explore all the new and modified requirements to assess how your organization will be affected by the revised Standard. On completion of this course, your knowledge of the requirements of ISO 14001 will enable you to plan for the successful transition of your organization's EMS.

How You Will Benefit:

After completing this training course, you will be able to:

- *Identify and understand the key changes between ISO 14001:2004 and ISO 14001:2015.*
- *Define the context of your organization, including needs and expectations of interested parties and their relationship to the organization's strategic risks and opportunities.*
- *Interpret the application of risk-based thinking, leadership, process management, lifecycle thinking and sustainability for your organization.*
- *Create a model for your organization that shows how the process approach could be used for planning, supporting, operating, controlling, and evaluating processes.*
- *Identify gaps in your current EMS system using an ETI Group assessment tool.*
- *Create an action plan to transition your company from ISO 14001:2004 to ISO 14001:2015.*

Who Should Attend

People involved in planning, implementing, maintaining, and auditing Environmental Management Systems based on ISO 14001. The course is primarily focused on organizations currently certified to ISO 14001:2004 and preparing to transition to ISO 14001:2015. People interested in learning how to implement ISO 14001:2015 from the ground up will also benefit from this course.

Course Duration:

This course will take 2-days (16 –hours) to complete.

Course Prerequisites:

A basic understanding of ISO 14001:2004 would be beneficial but not essential to attend this course.

Course Fees:

This training course can be delivered in a classroom setting or as an instructor-led virtual, online training course. Your cost, including workbooks for each participant is \$450 per person.
